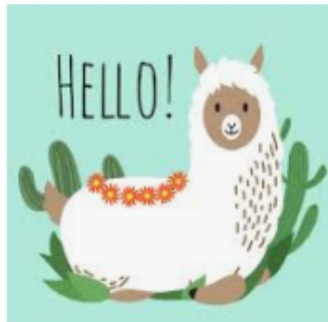


Friday



Today is our final day to add to our book and to add any finishing touches! We are going to add a final African animal to page 4 of our book and you also have the option of adding page 5 - your favourite African animal and why.

Make sure you've got everything you need to get creating!

Step 1:

Choose a final African animal of your choice to include on page 4 of your book.

You can use the power point, google or even animal books from home to help you!



Step 2:

- Draw a picture of your animal on your paper and colour it in
- Write the name of the animal beneath the picture

Step 3:

*Cut out a piece of paper or card that is the correct size to cover your picture*

Step 4:

*Write some facts/ clues on your piece of card/ paper*



- You can number your facts
- You can use bullet points
- You can write as many clues as you like
- You can even make your clues really tricky so the person reading finds it hard to guess the animal!

Step 5:

Use your glue or sticky tape to attach your facts on top of your picture



You need to be able to lift the flap so don't stick the whole piece on top of your picture...stick the top or the side instead!

Step 6: Create page 5 - your favourite African animal. Include a picture and some amazing facts about it!

My favourite African animal is the meerkat.
