





can affect our surroundings as well as us.







Climates Countries around the

Different instruments can be used to measure and record the weather.






Seasonal Changes



There are 7 different Continents on Earth. These are: Asia, Africa, Europe, Australia, North America, South America and Antarctica.

• The Earth has 5 Oceans: Atlantic, Pacific, Indian, Arctic and Southern.

 The Equator and the Polesis. The Equator is an imaginary line in the middle of the Earth. The Countries that are Close to the Equator are hotter and drier because the sun shines most directly on the Equator all year round.

The Countries that are furthest away from the Equator are Colder and wetter because the sun shines less directly on these areas.
