

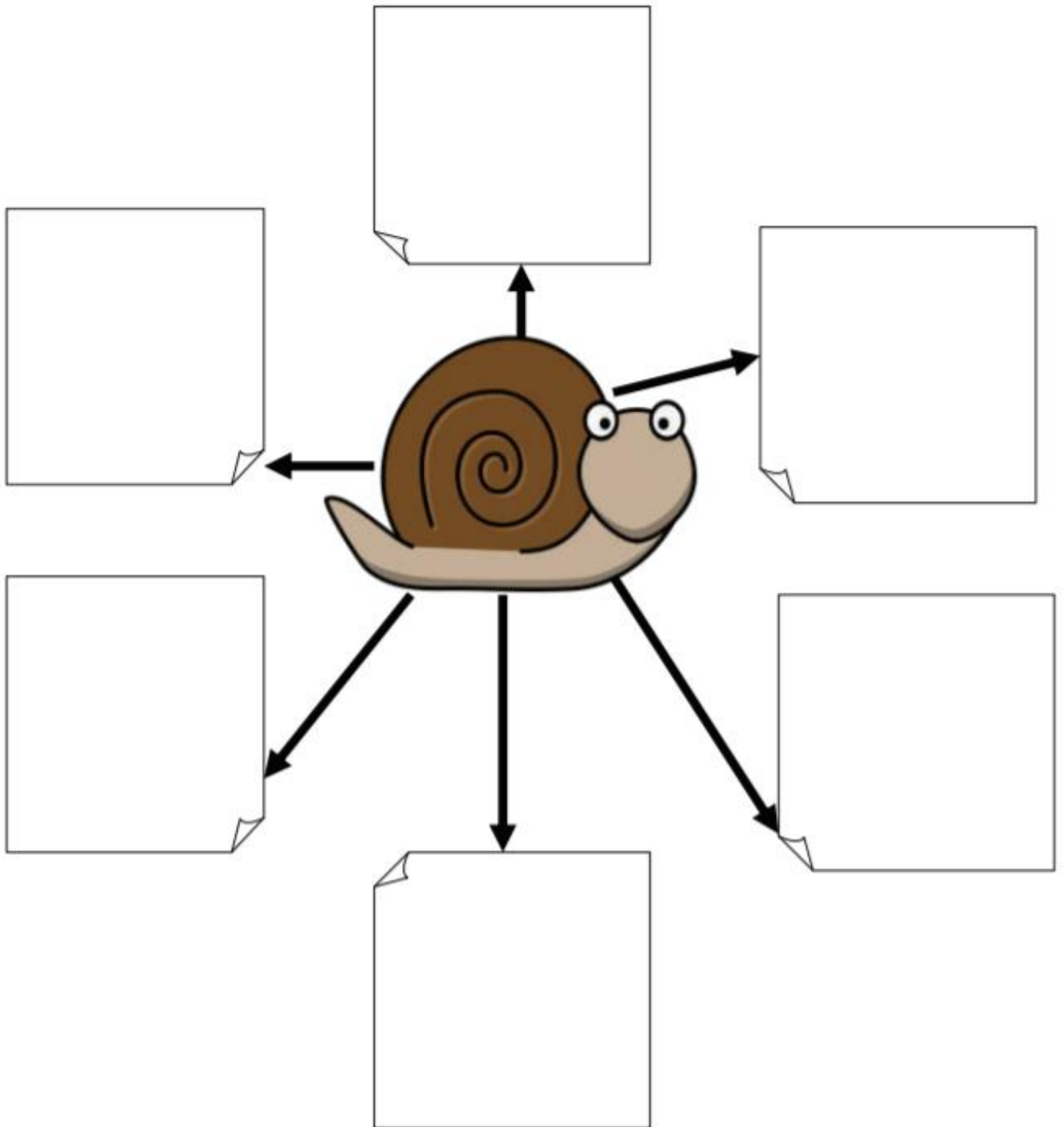


MEERKATS ENGLISH WEEK 4
