Date	Event
Friday 28th June	Sports day – a morning of activities for the children. Parents and families welcome to join us in the afternoon. Please do not arrive before 1pm as the gate will be locked. You will be able to come in after 1pm and the event will start at 1.15pm. Remember blankets/ chairs/ refreshments etc. The children are also taking part in a carousel of fun sports activities in the morning, so will be outside all day. The weather forecast currently looks like we should have pleasant weather, but please ensure children all have a water bottle, sun cream and a hat with them.
Tuesday 2nd and Wednesday 3rd July	Transition days for our Y6 pupils who are moving to Sharnbrook Academy
Wednesday 3rd July	Moving up day. Children to spend the day in their new class for September. When the bell goes at 8.50 am, children will head straight to their new classroom. Please note, our new Reception children are in until 1pm, not for the whole day.
Wednesday 3rd July	'Meet the teacher' meetings for parents/carers of our new Reception children. This will be at 5.30 pm.
Thursday 4th July	'Meet the teacher' meetings. An opportunity for parents of children moving into a new class (those moving into Y1, Y3 and Y5) to meet their child's new teacher. Straight after school at 3.20pm Meetings will last 20-30 minutes and take place in each classroom. If any parents/carers have children in more than one class, then please pick one to go to first and move onto the second afterwards. Teachers are preparing a 'Meet the teacher' leaflet, so please do not worry if you are not able to make this meeting as a leaflet will be sent home, which will hopefully answer many of your questions.
Monday 8th July	KS2 Children (Years 3-6) will perform our end of year production, 'OLIVIA!'. There will be two performances at 2pm and 6pm. Information about tickets has already been sent out.

Monday 15th July	9.15 am A short concert will be given by our piano and violin pupils. Mrs Edwards has already contacted their parents inviting them in to watch.
Monday 15th July	Workshare All parents and carers are invited to look at children's work. This will happen straight after school until 4pm in classrooms.
Friday 19th July	Parents, carers and families of our Year 6 pupils are warmly invited to join us in the school hall at 9am for our Leavers Assembly. Refreshments will be served afterwards for those able to stay around for a few more minutes.
