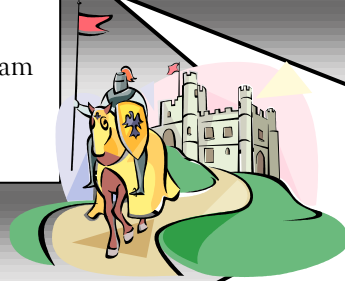


PHYSICAL EDUCATION
