

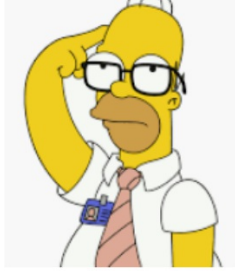


Week - long task

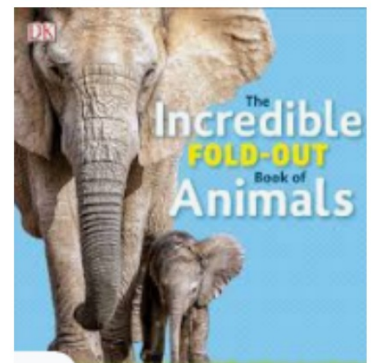


-pencil/pen/colours/scissors/glue/sticky tape
