Instead, we will organise a range of fun activities to mark the occasion. We would love to have some parents, carers and grandparents come in and read a favourite book to small groups of children. If this is something you might be interested in, please let myself (Mrs Smith) know, or the office. The children will also bring home their World Book Day voucher. This entitles them to one of the special WBD books or £1 off a different book.

Uniform reminders

A proud moment

We love to see the children showing and telling us their achievements from home in our Friday 'Achievement Assemblies'. Please do encourage your children to share- we often look at wonderful art work, brilliant models and hear about sporting achievements. In addition, we sing Happy Birthday to those children who are celebrating, the House Captains announce the house points for the week and we see which class has the highest attendance that week. The whole assembly is led by our Y6 pupils, who take it in turns, as one of their responsibility jobs. It really is one of the best bits of the week!

I particularly wanted to share with you the extraordinary sporting achievements of one of our pupils. Joey is in Year 4 and is truly a rising star in the world of BMX. In 2022, Joey raced the 10 round HSBC National BMX series for Milton Keynes BMX club. His goal was to reach the A final at each round (this is the top 8 riders) and therefore qualify for the 2023 World Championships in Glasgow.

His race category, 'Expert male 8s', usually fields 50 riders. Each round compromises 3 Qualifying races, followed by a Quarter Final, Semi Final and A Final.

Joey's results were:

Rounds 1 & 2 Manchester: 4th, 4th

Rounds 3 & 4 Gravesend: 2nd, 2nd

Rounds 5 & 6 Glasgow: 2nd, 3rd

Rounds 7 & 8 Peckham: 2nd, 3rd

Rounds 9 & 10 Birmingham: 4th, 5th

This gave him a **National number 2 ranking**, qualifying for the Glasgow **World Championships** in August 2023, representing Great Britain.

In addition this year, Joey will again contest the National series, plus European championship rounds in Belgium and France, for his new sponsor, Team BMX Hype.
